### What to Know B4 You Go

At Mexican International Airports, tickets are purchased for the taxi before you leave the building. Look for the kiosk. Prices are fixed and drivers and their vehicles are registered with the proper authorities. This protects tourists from price gouging and disreputable drivers.

Simply state how many people are in your group, and where you are going.

Once you purchase your ticket, follow the signs to the taxi stand, and wait your turn.

There is usually an attendant who will take your ticket and direct you into the correct line (fila or cola):
